After these dates, trees will need to be put out with EXTRA trash and will not be recycled.

Let it Snow, Let it Snow, Let it Snow!

- **Keep the sidewalk in front of your property clear.** Shovel the snow into your yard and enjoy the benefits in the spring after it melts!
- **Do not shovel the snow into the street.** This inhibits proper drainage and can cause a big mess.
- Remember that the Town will only plow the streets if there is accumulation of at least 6" on the ground with a projection of more to come within the next twelve hours.



- The roads are plowed to the middle of most roads. This is to prevent large berms from accumulating in front of sidewalks and driveways.
