Starting at 5:00pm with Gazebo Lighting at 6:00pm

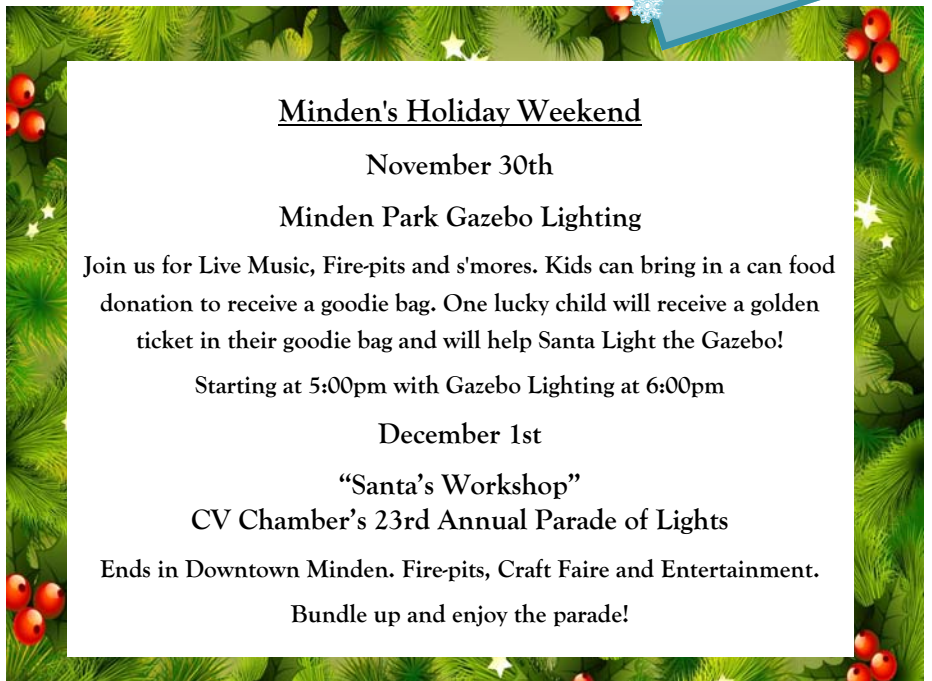

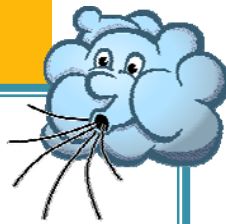

Trash Tips & Fall Cleanup

We live in such a giving and caring community. Anyone who has participated in the Channel 2 Share Your Christmas Drive-By Food Drive knows that our valley is exceptional. The Town of Minden wants to help our residents be a part of this great event from the convenience of your own home! The week of December 7th, put your food donations out by your trash can on your regularly scheduled trash day by 6:00 am and we will drive by to collect it. You can also drop your donations off to our Administrative Office. Last year, they were able to collect a total of 262,489 lbs. of food & raise \$58,341.89. Let's beat last year!



Feel free to put your address on your trash cans to help keep track of them if it gets too windy and they take a trip down the street.



- ◆ No trash pickup on Thanksgiving Day. Residents with Thursday trash pickup need to put it out the day before by 6:00am.
- ◆ No green waste pickup the week of Thanksgiving, Christmas or New Years.
- ◆ **NO TRASH IN YOUR GREEN WASTE CAN.**
- ◆ All cans need to be out by 6:00am the day of pickup.
- ◆ Extra Trash is your third trash pickup of the month. It must be bagged or bundled up off to the side of your can.
- ◆ Please do not overfill cans. Cans that are too heavy will be tagged and not picked up.
